Crystal Green Memorial Scholarship



Crystal Green was a valiant and loving young woman that set forth the example of kindness and care to all that she met.

Crystal, who graduated from Dade County High School, was a student at Georgia

Southern University before suffering a setback with aplastic anemia, a blood disorder. After hundreds of hours of platelet transfusions and a bone marrow transplant, Crystal lost her long battle in 1998, shortly after turning 21.

In her honor, Blood Assurance in 1999 established a scholarship fund for high school students seeking to better themselves and aspiring to give back to the communities from which they came.

The program offers a total of twelve (1) one-year scholarships in the amount of \$1,500 each.

Applicants are judged on a written application, high school transcript, school and community service, letters of recommendation, and a marketing plan for a blood drive.

Financial need is a consideration, as one of the primary goals is to help a student who might not otherwise be able to make it without the assistance.

Project Lifeline

As part of the Project Lifeline program, high school seniors who attend schools that host blood drives with Blood Assurance are eligible to apply for the Crystal Green Memorial Scholarship, regardless of the individual's donation history.

High school students account for 13% of the area's annual blood donations.

Crystal required multiple blood transfusions during her battle with aplastic anemia. Blood drives held at these high schools help to ensure that countless patients in our area receive the life-saving blood transfusions they need.



Supporting the Scholarship Fund

Provide 1 scholarship = \$1,500

Provide 12 scholarships = \$18,000



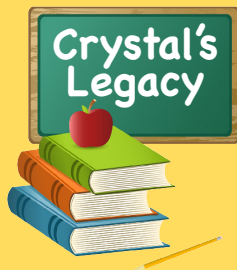
Golf Tournament
